What is the French-Italian University?

- Created in 1998 by an inter-governmental agreement
- First activities in 2001
- New agreement signed in 2014 to ensure a smoother running of the programs
- A «virtual » university : no walls, no teachers, no students!
 - ✓ To promote mobility and scientific collaboration between French and Italian Higher Education Institutions in the spirit of the Bologna process.



Principaux objectifs

It works like a funding agency to:

- Foster academic cooperation between Italy and France
- Favor the implementation of join or multiple diplomas
- Promote scientific and/or technological joint research activities
- Foster the development of HEI consortia including other EU countries

1. VINCI Program

To support Master courses, PhD students as well as post-doc and academics

1) Master binational curricula

2) PhD students mobility in the frame of joint supervision theses

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=> 21 projects  
■ + 21 projects  
■ (~ 5 000 € /project)
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3) PhD grants for joint thesis supervision

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=> 3 grants + 3 grants
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(~ 20 000 € /year)

4) Post-doc integration into professional life

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=> 2 projects + 2 projects
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(24 000 € /project)

Deadline for on line registration:

February 6th 2018 (12.00 AM)

Results: June 2018



2. UFI Scientific Label

The label is delivered to French-Italian initiatives demonstrating a high level of cooperation and a firm cultural/scientific importance:

- seminars, conferences, colloquiums,
- exhibitions, cultural shows
- joined curricula and diplomas
- publications, journals
- simultaneous translations,...

Deadline for on line application: January 29th 2018

Results: June 2018 (for activities running during the 2nd semester 2018)

Financial support: max 2 000 € / project



3. Visiting Professors

The program support the mobility of a French scientist to an Italian University for a teaching period of at least 3 months. Up to now, this mobility scheme has been supported only from France to Italy, but from the next year teaching mobility will be supported in both directions.

Funding available: 6 000€ from UFI + 6 000€ from the host University. 4 grants.

September 2018

Results: December 2018

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4. Partenariats Hubert Curien (PHC) / Galileo program This program is managed by the Italian-French University for the Italian part, and by the MEIRIES and Campus France for the French side. The program is aimed at promoting new cooperation's for innovative issues and covers the mobility of young researchers from a French research team to an Italian one and the other way around.

≃ 20 projects are supported (≃ 4 000 € /project)
