R&D expenditure (% of GDP):


- 1,72% in the UK

£9,250 a year for UK and EU students (~76% of univ. charging the full amount)






Foreign students and academics in UK universities


In the UK, foreigners account for:

Academic Staff




The UK is the 1st country of destination for EU27 students mobility
