Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Individual Fellowships

Mobility rule:

You can't have spent more than 12 months in the past 36 months in the country of your host institution (36 months in the past 5 years if hosted by a non-academic institution).

All fields, all nationalities, without age restriction.

Host institution:

- universities, research institutes
- companies, foundations, associations, museums, international organisations... with research activities

2 types of IF: European fellowships / Global fellowships

- European fellowships: 12-36 months in Europe or associated countries (eg Turkey, Israel...)
- Global fellowships: 12-24 months in Europe + 12 months as inbound phase in Europe

Living allowance : 4.280€ (+ family allowance + mobility allowance)

Proposal must be submitted by the researcher together with the host institution.
