

MOPGA PROGRAMME



- Started in 2017
- Programme for :
 - Students: Master and PhD
 - Researchers: Post-doc, advanced researchers
- Climate change topics (climate change & sustainability sciences, earth system sciences, energy transition, societal challenges on environmental issues, One Health)
- 8 calls since 2017: 2 Masters, 1 PhD, 4 Post-doc and 1 short-stay 255 laureates (including 8 Italians + 2 Italian candidates for MOPGA 4 out of 171 candidates)
- **New call(s)** to come in 2021/22 : Post-doc
- Entirely financed by France









EIFFEL DOCTORATE PROGRAMME

- Funding over 12 months in the frame of a joint supervision or co-supervised doctorate.
- 4 target areas : Sciences and Engineering Sciences ; Economics and Management ; Law ; Political Sciences.
- Monthly allowance of 1 700 € (since January 2021) ; international trip to France ; social security ; cultural activities ; housing financial help under specific conditions.
- 2022 call for applications calendar:
 - Submission of online applications: week of September 27, 2021,
 - Deadline for receipt of applications by Campus France: January 7, 2022,
 - Publication of results: week of April 4, 2022.

PHC DEFINITION



- Facilitate the mobility of researchers with the double objective of:
 - Developing scientific and technological exchanges between French and Italian laboratories,
 - Promoting new scientific collaborations and integrating in the projects young researchers and PhD students.
- Research projects are joint ventures between a French and an Italian research team.
- Funding: French Ministries of Europe and Foreign Affairs and of Higher Education, Research and Innovation







- o 1994: Creation of the PHC Galilée
- o Average budget (France + Italy): around 140 000€/year
 - French budget: around 70 000€/year,
 - Italian budget: around 70 000€/year
 - Average budget per project (France + Italy): around 8 000€/year
- Average number of new funded projects per year: around 12 to 15
- From 2005 to 2020: 1880 applications submitted & 359 projects funded
